For more information on NatureBridge's Henness Ridge campus visit online at https://naturebridge.org/newhome With the first phase of construction almost completed, NatureBridge plans to open its new Henness Ridge campus "The National Environmental Science Center at Yosemite" (NESC) this August 2018.

Amongst plenty new opportunities for young learners, the site based curriculum includes fire science. One long term goal of NatureBridge is to add a firehouse to the expansion of buildings that encompasses additional cabins, a formal dining hall, a library, a laboratory and classroom spaces. The estimated total costs for the campus are \$53 million, of which \$22 million had come entirely from private donors. The proposed figure for the firehouse runs at \$2 million for construction, which will kick off with \$1.2 million in funds raised.

The firehouse is designed as a two bay building with an office and classroom/briefing room. The facility will provide designated space for National Park Service staff. In the event of a park wide emergency, the firehouse could potentially be utilized as a command center.

The realization of the HennessRidge firehouse relies solely on public funding. How can we help? Is this an initiative Yosemite West Property and Homeowners. Inc. should foster?
