By participating in the survey, you will help strengthen grant proposals by demonstrating what our community is doing to help protect ourselves from wildland fire. We encourage everyone to participate, since the more volunteer labor we can document, the more grant monies our community may be eligible to receive as matching funds for the in-kind services.
