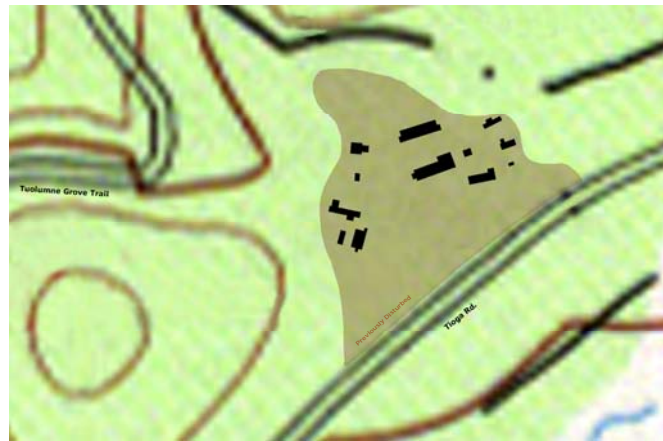


The Mission of Yosemite National Institutes is to provide experiential field science programs in nature's classroom to inspire a personal connection to the natural world and responsible actions to sustain it.



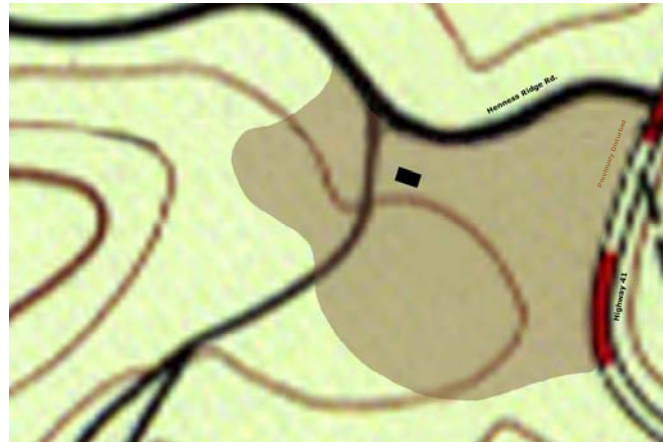
Crane Flat Site Existing Conditions

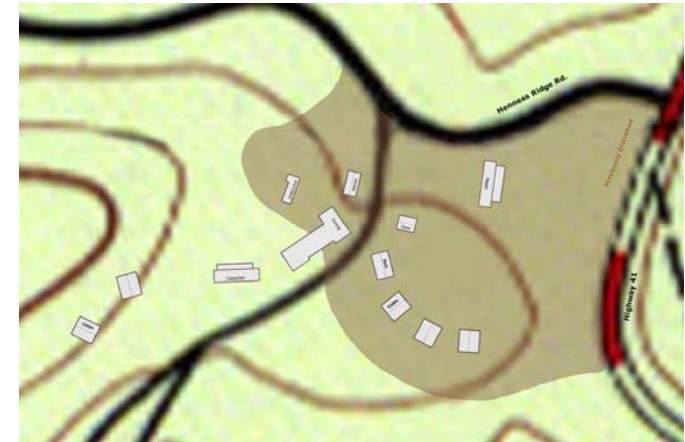
Conceptual Plan for 170 Bed Campus at the Crane Flat Site
