1) Labor Day meeting scheduling

We need to nominate members for election, including the four members with expiring terms. Ted will host via Microsoft Teams. Katrin volunteered to help coordinate online comments during the meeting.

2) Annual meeting additional content

Inviting Rosemarie Smallcombe seems like the best option. When date gets closer, Ted will check her availability to join the call for a Q&A session with the community. The meeting day proposed is Tuesday September 1 so as to not conflict with the Labor Day road-trips, and meeting time can be 7pm since phone meeting doesn't need to be in daytime.

5) YWDAC meetings updates

- June 11 YWDAC main quarterly meeting plus July 9, 2020 special meeting to review Provost&Pritchard report on proposed water expansion.

- YW Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) documents say that building permits won't be denied if we run out of wastewater capacity but instead everyone's capacity will be reduced.
- Acquisition of additional leach field property to increase WWTF capacity. As of June 11th meeting, county and seller hadn't reached a price. There's been some meetings since then, but we haven't heard more.
- Zone of Benefit from 2018 invalidated. Mike Healy said the county would start a process to request refunds and give us the details, but a month later we've heard nothing. June 30 meter reading should be the last reading with the higher rates. Old meter readings may be necessary to get a refund. Apparently, one can file a "claim" with the County by letter to the Clerk of the Board.
- New rate study was commissioned by Mariposa BoS with Bartle Wells Associates, in preparation for another round of utility rate-increase. Old rate study in 2017 ignored half of the revenue, which is the half that comes from property taxes, and likely overestimated the necessary rate increase as a result. We need to make sure that this round of rate-increase proposal properly counts this revenue source.
- YWMD is considering sale of water to NESC (Nature Bridge) without clear justification or notification. Provost & Pritchard report initiated in January was delivered in June and discussed in the July 9 YWDAC meeting. Idea of infrastructure partnership was rejected as not viable by Provost & Pritchard, and thus the only proposal considered was adding Nature Bridge as just another customer despite their size and with no return benefit to the community other than paying per gallon for the water they use.

6) Yosemite Conservancy land development

7) Community mailing
