

Sign up for Free Chipping

Participation takes three easy steps:

1. Make your curbside pile(s).
2. Flag your pile(s) using the flagging tape provided in the mailbox shed.
3. Email grants@yosemitewest.org to let us know you have pile(s).

There is no set date for chipping; crews will “sweep” through the community periodically throughout the duration of the project. However, we would urge you to make your first pile(s) by Memorial Day weekend. Property owners do *not* have to be present when the chipper comes. The chips will be blown back and dispersed onto your property as determined by the crew

Chipping Pile Guidelines

Chipping Do's

- ✓ Hand pile brush and branches with cut ends pointing in the same direction towards the street.
- ✓ Generate substantial-sized piles; consolidate piles with your neighbors where possible, which will speed up chipping.

Chipping Don'ts

- ✗ No piles in the street.
- ✗ No rocks, pine needles, pine cones, lumber, or garbage
- ✗ No limbs greater than 8” in diameter.
- ✗ No machine-made or dozer-made piles.
- ✗ No “kindling-sized” piles; which wastes the crew’s time (i.e., if it looks like kindling, it is).
